On January 5, 2022 a village resident was arrested for menacing by stalking and booked in the Ashland County Jail. A complaint was made in October 2021 and a report was filed on December 15, 2021 detailing this case. The alleged harassment stems over eight years as an apparent feud between neighbors. This was a proactive enforcement action taken to prevent a more serious situation.

The Mifflin Police Department takes these incidents very seriously as they can lead to injury and death. In 2017 U.S. Senator Rand Paul was seriously injured in a dispute with a neighbor. In 2018, two neighbors were shot and killed over a dispute of where to shovel snow; the gunman later killed himself. These are just two events that gained national attention. The Mifflin Police Department takes pride in the low crime rate within the village and strives to protect and serve those that reside in and visit the village.
