Good morning Captain Perry,

Thank you for notifying the Bureau of Adult Detention of the Critical Incident (Death In Custody-Justin Horner-12/17/23) that occurred at the Ashland Co. Jail.

Please provide the following information regarding the Critical Incident (Answer each question to the **right** of each item):

- Time admitted (booked): 1152 hours
- Age: 31
- Gender: Male
- Race: White
- Charges: Illegal Use or Possession of Drug Paraphernalia/Possession of a Fentanyl related compound
- Sentence status: Pre-Sentence

- Prior Arrests? No
- On Suicide Watch at the time of the incident? [REDACTED]
- Where the incident took place: Booking Cell
- Description of Incident: Offender complained he wasn't feeling well during the early morning hours (approx 0250 hours) on 11/17/23 during his incarceration of a Housing Unit. He was moved to Booking and place on observation checks. Vitals were reported [REDACTED] and 10 minute observation and 30 minute visual checks were conducted from Booking. At approximately 1303 hours (11/17/23) Offender indicated to one of the correctional officers [REDACTED]. The officer asked him to sit down and notified our nurse. At 1318 hours a corrections officer observed him unresponsive and notified the nurse that she was needed in Booking. When she appeared at 1318 hours she advised for EMS to be contacted and asked for the AED unit. CPR was immediately administered until EMS arrived approximately 8 minutes later. After a pulse was detected he was transferred to ER. At approximately 2340 hours I received a call that he had passed away. Autopsy results should be available on 11/21/23. --Captain Joe Perry, Ashland County Sheriff's Office.

Additionally, please provide documentation of the Incident/Investigation report(s), copies of Jail Logs for a period of 24 hours before the incident and 24 hours after the incident (**please identify/highlight what cell/pod the inmate was housed on the log**), and information as to the number of similar incidents in the last 12 months. Please let me know when this information is available for review, and I can pick it up at your facility.
