Motivation: Construct a purpose-built terminal building at the Ashland County Airport to function as a base of operations for the airspace support (3G4), Part 141 flight school, and provide functional public meeting space.

November 2021



Combination of public space, fixed base of operations, and flight school




Proposed Floor Plan




