This matter came on for a change of plea this 25th day of April, 2024. The Defendant was present by video represented by Attorney Joseph P. Kearns, Jr.. The State of Ohio was present by video represented by Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Christopher R. Tunnell.

The Court inquired of the Defendant as to whether she was a citizen of the United States and the Defendant responded affirmatively.

The Defendant, through her attorney, requested to withdraw her former plea of not guilty and enter a plea of guilty subject to the Court accepting the plea of guilty to the following charge(s):

COUNT ONE: §2913.02(A)(1): Petty Theft M1

The Court explained to the Defendant her Constitutional Rights including those rights enumerated in Ohio Criminal Rule 11, and that by entering a plea of guilty, the Defendant was waiving those rights.

Whereupon, based upon the Court's inquiry of and explanation to the Defendant, the Court finds that Defendant fully understands all of her Constitutional Rights and the other matters connected with her plea and knowing and understanding all of same has voluntarily entered a plea of guilty to the charge(s). Said plea is accepted and the Court finds the Defendant guilty of the above-stated charge(s).

The State moved the Court for permission to dismiss Count(s)

Based upon the request of the State, the Court sustains the motion of the State and ORDERS the dismissal of Count(s)

It is hereby ORDERED that a pre-sentence investigation be conducted.

Whereupon, the Court scheduled this matter for sentencing on

June 10, 2024 at 9:00 a.m.

Bond continued.


