

Loudonville P.D. Police Calls

- 5/24 at 2:00am, Police performed a welfare check on a unconscious male laying in the grass in the 200 block of E. Washington St. The male was intoxicated and released to a sober and responsible family member.
- 5/24 at 1:24pm, Police received a theft complaint at Dollar General. Investigations revealed the suspected male had checked out at an employee staffed register and the employee had not advised the male that his payment did not go through. The male returned to the store to pay for the goods.
