

Loudonville P.D. Police Calls

- 6/14 at 12:59am, police were dispatched to a business in the 300 block of West Main Street to the report of an abandon vehicle. The vehicle owner was contacted and advised that the vehicle had broken down and attempts were being made to make the vehicle operable.
