

Loudonville P.D. Police Calls

- 7/5 at 12:07am, police were contacted by a caller who wished to report their vehicle as missing or possibly stolen. The caller stated that they parked the vehicle in the 300 block of South Water Street during the fireworks and, after the fireworks, were unable to locate the vehicle. The area was checked, but the vehicle was not located on this night. The vehicle was later located by the caller, who had forgotten where the vehicle was actually parked.
